

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Eyelid Surgery

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Eyelid Rejuvenation

Sometimes, even after a great night's sleep, it can be hard to feel alive and vibrant when you see those tired, drooping eyes looking back at you from the mirror. The loose skin and wrinkles make you look more tired and older then you feel inside. If this sounds familiar, you're not alone. Each year thousands of women and men choose eyelid surgery to help restore



a more energetic and youthful appearance. Eyelid surgery, or blepharoplasty, can correct sagging eyelids, remove fatty pouches beneath the

eyes and remove excess skin from the upper eyelids. Blepharoplasty can be done alone or in conjunction with other procedures such as laser skin resurfacing to rejuvenate the entire face.

<u> Your Consultation</u>

During your initial consultation, Dr. Reichel will discuss your particular condition, your expectations, and the probable outcome of treatment. She may ask you to bring in photos from 10 or 15 years ago to examine at the shape and look of your eyes when you were younger. You will be shown several before and after treatment photographs of patients having similar conditions, and you will receive an explanation of your treatment. Before and after photos may

be taken of the area to be treated to document your results. Dr. Reichel is happy to discuss other aspects of face and eye aging and will come up with a plan



that offers you tailored rejuvenation treatment.







The Procedure

Dr. Reichel performs eyelid surgery under local anesthesia which avoids the risks associated with general anesthesia. For patient comfort, we also give a light sedative before we begin. Your blepharoplasty procedure will be performed in our AAAHC accredited ambulatory surgery center. Working in an accredited surgery center assures the highest level of patient safety. For upper eyelids, Dr. Reichel places fine incisions in the natural crease above each eye. A thin crescent of excess skin and muscle is then removed. If excess fatty deposits are present, these will also be removed. The incisions are closed with very fine sutures. To remove the fatty deposits beneath the eyes, the incisions are placed just inside the lower eyelid. After the fat is removed, the incision for the lower eyelid is left to heal naturally. When excess skin and muscle need to be removed from the lower lids, the incisions are placed in the natural smile crease below the lashline. The procedure can take between one and two hours, depending on the extent of the surgery.

What about Recovery?

After the surgery, the area around your eyes will be bruised and swollen for about one week. Pain is usually very mild and can be controlled with oral pain medication. For the first few nights, you should keep your head up and will be directed to use cold compresses on your eyes periodically. Antibiotic eye drops or ointment may be prescribed. If you use contact lenses, you will be asked to wear glasses for about two weeks, since the eyelids may be stiff and sore. Make-up may be worn after about seven days. The thin hairline scars which follow the natural contour of the eyelids tend to fade in about two months.

Eyelid surgery is one of Dr. Reichel's favorite procedures. Patients are so happy with the results. Within a few months, you will look rested and youthful. We aim to rejuvenate the eyes and keep a natural look to the face.
